This letter from a missionary to one of his supporting churches not only displays the proper attitude for a missionary under persecution, but it also shows us how God views the sacrificial giving of His church.

to participate in gospel ministry throughout the world. But the need for solid, biblical, faithful ministry continues to grow. So as we begin a new year of Faith Promise, it's exciting to consider what the Lord has in store for the future, even as we celebrate what He has already accomplished.

During the past year Grace Church sent out eight new missionary families, and today we Our church has been privileged for many years support more than seventy families scattered

across six continents. Each of them is faithfully serving in a local church and working to spread the good news of the gospel in a myriad of ways. Some of our missionaries, like Martin and Gabi Manten in Switzerland, are planting model churches in regions essentially devoid of Christian witness. Others, like Davis Prickett in Africa, are working to translate the Word of God into new languages. And many others, like our missionary team in Spain, are diligently providing biblical training to national pastors



and church leaders in places with little or no viable options for strong biblical instruction. Through international training centers, these missionaries are equipping a generation of church leaders and Bible expositors to teach and preach God's Word the way it's preached here at Grace Church.

amount you would like to trust the Lord to provide over the next twelve months, fill out a card, and drop it in the offering plate or at the Faith Promise table on the patio. We rejoice to see the Lord provide and use us to advance His work, and we pray that our opportunities to serve, pray, and give toward His kingdom will only increase. As we trust in His provision, we know "that God will open up to us a door for the word, so that we may speak forth the mystery of Christ" (Colossians 4:3).
